Our newest offering is the A+ Program – a day school education and treatment program for children aged 10-14 who have been diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorders. The A+ Program is designed to provide both specialized academic instruction as well as treatment for the student’s emotional, behavioral, psychological, and social difficulties.
